Hello! What's Your Name?

Learn to greet people, introduce yourself and make new friends in English!

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

- ✓ Say hello and goodbye in different ways
- ✓ Ask someone's name with **"What's your name?"**
- ✓ Introduce yourself with **"My name is..."** and **"I'm..."**
- ✓ Use polite expressions: **please, thank you, sorry, you're welcome**
- ✓ Have a short introduction conversation with a friend

Part 1: Greeting Words – Saying Hello!

When we **meet** someone, we **greet** them! There are many ways to say hello in English. Some are for **any time of the day** and some are for a **specific time**.

Greeting	When To Use It	Feeling
Hello!	Any time of the day	Polite & friendly
Hi!	Any time of the day	Casual & fun
Good morning!	Before 12:00 (noon)	Fresh & bright
Good afternoon!	12:00 – 6:00 PM	Warm & polite
Good evening!	After 6:00 PM	Calm & polite

FUN FACT: "Hi" and "Hello" mean the same thing! "Hi" is what we say to **friends** and "Hello" is what we say to **teachers** or **adults**. You can use both!

Part 2: Goodbye Words – See You Later!

When we **leave**, we say **goodbye**! There are many fun ways to do it:

Farewell	When To Use It	Example
Goodbye!	Any time you leave	Goodbye, teacher!
Bye!	Casual, with friends	Bye, Tom!
See you!	When you will meet again	See you tomorrow!
See you later!	When you will meet soon	See you later!
Good night!	Before going to sleep	Good night, Mum!

Part 3: What's Your Name?

Now let's learn the **most important question** when you meet someone new!

How to ask:

Question	Meaning
What's your name?	You want to know someone's name
What is your name?	Same question, longer form

REMEMBER: "What's" = "What is" — It's a short form! We call this a **contraction**.

How to answer:

Answer	Example	Notes
My name is ___.	My name is <i>Emma</i> .	Full answer
I'm ___.	I'm <i>Ali</i> .	Short answer
I am ___.	I am <i>Yuki</i> .	Full form of "I'm"

TIP: Both "My name is..." and "I'm..." are correct! "I'm" is short for "I am" — just like "What's" is short for "What is". Easy!

Part 4: Nice to Meet You!

After you learn someone's name, you can be **polite** and say:

You Say	They Say Back
Nice to meet you!	Nice to meet you too!

Let's also learn other **magic polite words** that make everyone happy!

Polite Word	When To Use It	Example
Please	When you ask for something nicely	Can I have water, <i>please</i> ?
Thank you	When someone helps you	<i>Thank you</i> , teacher!
Thanks	Casual way to say thank you	<i>Thanks!</i>
You're welcome	When someone thanks you	<i>You're welcome!</i>
Sorry	When you make a mistake	<i>Sorry!</i> I didn't mean it.
Excuse me	When you want attention politely	<i>Excuse me</i> , can you help me?

Part 5: A Real Conversation!

Let's see how a **real introduction** looks! Read this conversation between **Lily** and **Tom**:

Lily:	Hello!
Tom:	Hi!
Lily:	What's your name?
Tom:	My name is Tom. What's your name?
Lily:	I'm Lily. Nice to meet you, Tom!
Tom:	Nice to meet you too, Lily!
Lily:	Goodbye, Tom! See you later!
Tom:	Bye, Lily! See you!

NOTICE: Lily used "**I'm Lily**" and Tom used "**My name is Tom**". Both are perfect! They also said "**Nice to meet you**" — that's polite!
