My Family

Learn the names of family members and introduce your family in English!

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

- ✓ Name **immediate family**: mother, father, sister, brother, baby
- ✓ Name **extended family**: grandmother, grandfather, aunt, uncle, cousin
- ✓ Introduce family: **"This is my mother. Her name is Sara."**
- ✓ Use **possessive adjectives**: my, your, his, her
- ✓ Ask and answer: **"Who is this?"**

Part 1: My Immediate Family

Your **immediate family** are the people who live in your home:

MOTHER	FATHER	SISTER	BROTHER	BABY
also: Mum / Mom	also: Dad / Daddy	a girl in your family	a boy in your family	a very young child

GOOD TO KNOW: "Mum" is British English and "Mom" is American English. Both are correct! "Dad" is the same in both.

Part 2: My Extended Family

Your **extended family** are relatives who may not live in your home:

GRANDMOTHE R	GRANDFATHE R	AUNT	UNCLE	COUSIN
also: Grandma	also: Grandpa	parent's sister	parent's brother	aunt/uncle's child

REMEMBER: You can have TWO grandmothers and TWO grandfathers — one from each parent!

Part 3: A Family Tree

A **family tree** shows how family members are connected. Here is Lily's family:

GRANDMOTHER Mary	GRANDFATHER John		
↓	↓		
MOTHER Sara	FATHER Tom	AUNT Kate	UNCLE James
↓	↓	↓	
LILY (ME!) Lily	BROTHER Ben	COUSIN Max

Part 4: Introducing Your Family

Sentence	Example
This is my mother.	This is my mother. Her name is Sara.
This is my father.	This is my father. His name is Tom.
This is my sister.	This is my sister. Her name is Mia.
This is my brother.	This is my brother. His name is Ben.
This is my grandmother.	This is my grandmother. Her name is Mary.
This is my grandfather.	This is my grandfather. His name is John.

Part 5: My, Your, His, Her

We use **possessive adjectives** to show who something belongs to:

Person	Possessive	Example	Meaning
I	my	This is <i>my</i> family.	Belongs to ME
you	your	Is this <i>your</i> brother?	Belongs to YOU
he	his	<i>His</i> name is Tom.	BOY / MAN
she	her	<i>Her</i> name is Lily.	GIRL / WOMAN

BE CAREFUL: "His" = boys/men. "Her" = girls/women. Don't mix them up! "Her name is Tom" is WRONG — Tom is a boy, so say "His name is Tom."

Part 6: Who Is This?

Question	Answer
Who is this?	This is my mother .
Who is this?	This is my brother . His name is Ben.
Who is she?	She is my aunt . Her name is Kate.
Who is he?	He is my uncle . His name is James.

TIP: Use "Who is this?" when you point. Use "Who is she?" for a girl/woman and "Who is he?" for a boy/man.
