How's the Weather?

Learn weather words, talk about seasons, and describe what to wear!

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

- ✓ Name **8 weather types**: sunny, cloudy, rainy, stormy, snowy, windy, foggy, rainbow
- ✓ Learn **5 temperature words**: hot, warm, cool, cold, freezing
- ✓ Ask and answer: "**How's the weather?**" – "**It's sunny.**"
- ✓ Name the **4 seasons** and their typical weather
- ✓ Connect weather to clothing: "**It's rainy. I need my umbrella.**"

Part 1: Weather Words

SUNNY	CLOUDY	RAINY	STORMY
"It's sunny!"	"It's cloudy."	"It's rainy."	"It's stormy!"
SNOWY	WINDY	FOGGY	RAINBOW
"It's snowy!"	"It's windy."	"It's foggy."	"There's a rainbow!"

Part 2: Hot & Cold – Temperature Words

Temperature	Meaning	Example
hot	very warm, high temperature	It is very hot in summer.
warm	a little hot, comfortable	It is warm and nice today.
cool	a little cold, fresh	It is cool in the morning.
cold	low temperature	It is very cold in winter.
freezing	extremely cold, below zero	It is freezing outside! Brr!

Part 3: Talking About the Weather

Question	Answer
How's the weather?	It's sunny .
What's the weather like?	It's rainy and cold .
What's the weather like today?	It's cloudy but warm .
Is it cold outside?	Yes, it is. / No, it isn't.
Is it raining?	Yes, it is raining. / No, it isn't.

TWO WAYS TO SAY IT:

- **It's sunny.** = **The sun is shining.**
- **It's rainy.** = **It is raining.**
- **It's snowy.** = **It is snowing.**
- **It's windy.** = **The wind is blowing.**

Part 4: Seasons of the Year

Season	Months	Typical Weather
Spring	March - May	warm, rainy, flowers grow
Summer	June - August	hot, sunny, long days
Autumn	September - November	cool, windy, leaves fall
Winter	December - February	cold, snowy, short days

SEASON PATTERNS:

- **In spring**, it is warm and rainy. Flowers start to grow.
- **In summer**, it is hot and sunny. We go to the beach!
- **In autumn**, it is cool and windy. The leaves change colour.
- **In winter**, it is cold and snowy. We wear warm clothes.
- "Autumn" = British English. "Fall" = American English. Both correct!

Part 5: What Should I Wear?

Weather	What to Wear	Sentence
Sunny & hot	T-shirt, shorts, sunglasses, hat	It's sunny. I wear my sunglasses .
Rainy	Raincoat, umbrella, boots	It's rainy. I need my umbrella .
Snowy & cold	Coat, scarf, gloves, boots	It's cold. I wear my coat .
Windy	Jacket, jumper	It's windy. I wear a jacket .
Warm	Light jacket, jeans	It's warm. I wear a light jacket .
