# My Clothes

Learn the names of clothes, describe what you are wearing, and dress for the weather!

## WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

- ✓ Name **16 clothing items** in English
- ✓ Use **"I'm wearing + colour + clothes"** to describe your outfit
- ✓ Ask and answer: **"What are you wearing?"**
- ✓ Use **He/She is wearing...** for other people
- ✓ Match **clothes to weather**

## Part 1: Clothes Vocabulary

<b>T-SHIRT</b>	<b>TROUSERS</b>	<b>DRESS</b>	<b>SHORTS</b>
top/body	legs	body+legs	legs (short)
<b>SHOES</b>	<b>SOCKS</b>	<b>COAT</b>	<b>JACKET</b>
feet	feet	cold days	cool days
<b>HAT</b>	<b>SCARF</b>	<b>GLOVES</b>	<b>BOOTS</b>
head	neck	hands	rain/snow
<b>SWIMSUIT</b>	<b>GLASSES</b>	<b>SUNGLASSES</b>	<b>TRAINERS</b>
swimming	eyes	sunny	sport

### SINGULAR vs PLURAL:

- **Singular:** a T-shirt, a dress, a hat, a coat, a jacket, a scarf
- **Always plural:** trousers, shorts, glasses, sunglasses, jeans
- **Pairs** (we wear two): shoes, socks, boots, gloves, trainers
- We say "a **pair of** trousers" / "a **pair of** shoes" for one set.

## Part 2: I'm Wearing...

Pattern	Example
I'm wearing + a + clothes.	I'm wearing a <i>T-shirt</i> .
I'm wearing + colour + clothes.	I'm wearing a <i>blue</i> T-shirt.
I'm wearing + clothes. (plural)	I'm wearing <i>black shoes</i> .
I'm not wearing + clothes.	I'm <i>not</i> wearing a hat.
Question	Answer
What are you wearing?	I'm wearing a red T-shirt and blue trousers.
Are you wearing a hat?	Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.
What is she wearing?	<b>She</b> is wearing a pink dress.
What is he wearing?	<b>He</b> is wearing a blue jacket.

### HE / SHE / THEY:

- I am wearing = **I'm** wearing (about ME)
- He is wearing = **He's** wearing (BOY/MAN)
- She is wearing = **She's** wearing (GIRL/WOMAN)

## Part 3: Clothes for Different Weather

Weather	What to Wear	Sentence
Hot & sunny	T-shirt, shorts, sunglasses	It's hot. I'm wearing <b>shorts</b> and a <b>T-shirt</b> .
Rainy	Coat, boots, hat	It's rainy. I'm wearing my <b>coat</b> and <b>boots</b> .
Cold & snowy	Coat, scarf, gloves, boots	It's cold. I'm wearing a <b>scarf</b> and <b>gloves</b> .
Cool	Jacket, trousers, trainers	It's cool. I'm wearing a <b>jacket</b> .
Swimming	Swimsuit	I'm wearing my <b>swimsuit</b> .

### Example Dialogue: New Clothes!

- Lily:** I like your T-shirt! What colour is it?
- Tom:** Thank you! It is green.
- Lily:** What are you wearing today?
- Tom:** I'm wearing a green T-shirt, blue trousers, and white trainers.

**Lily:** Cool! I'm wearing a red dress and black shoes.

**Creative Task:** Draw yourself and label your clothes in English!
