# Days of the Week

Learn all seven days, say what day it is, and talk about your week!

## WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

- ✓ Name all **7 days** of the week in order
- ✓ Spell each day correctly + **short forms** (Mon, Tue, Wed...)
- ✓ Ask and answer: "**What day is it today?**"
- ✓ Use **today, tomorrow, yesterday**
- ✓ Use "**on + day**": "I play football on Saturday."

## Part 1: The Seven Days

#	Full Name	Short	Type
1	<b>Monday</b>	Mon	Weekday
2	<b>Tuesday</b>	Tue	Weekday
3	<b>Wednesday</b>	Wed	Weekday
4	<b>Thursday</b>	Thu	Weekday
5	<b>Friday</b>	Fri	Weekday
6	<b>Saturday</b>	Sat	Weekend
7	<b>Sunday</b>	Sun	Weekend

### IMPORTANT RULES:

- Days **always start with a CAPITAL letter**: Monday, not monday.
- **Monday to Friday** = weekdays (school days!)
- **Saturday and Sunday** = the weekend (no school!)
- After Sunday, it goes back to Monday! 7 days = 1 week.

## Part 2: Spelling & Pronunciation

#	Full Name	Short	How to Say It
1	<b>Monday</b>	Mon	MUN-day
2	<b>Tuesday</b>	Tue	TYOOZ-day
3	<b>Wednesday</b>	Wed	WENZ-day (silent 'd')
4	<b>Thursday</b>	Thu	THURZ-day
5	<b>Friday</b>	Fri	FRY-day
6	<b>Saturday</b>	Sat	SAT-er-day
7	<b>Sunday</b>	Sun	SUN-day

### TRICKY SPELLING:

- **Wednesday** has a silent "d"! Write Wed-nes-day, say "WENZ-day".
- **Tuesday** starts with "Tue" not "Too" — remember the "ue"!
- **Thursday** starts with "Th" — don't confuse with Tuesday!

## Part 3: What Day Is It?

Question	Answer
<b>What day is it today?</b>	Today is <b>Monday</b> .
<b>What day is it tomorrow?</b>	Tomorrow is <b>Tuesday</b> .
<b>What day was yesterday?</b>	Yesterday was <b>Sunday</b> .

### TODAY / TOMORROW / YESTERDAY:

- **Today** = this day, right now.
- **Tomorrow** = the next day.
- **Yesterday** = the day before.

## Part 4: On + Day

Use "on" before a day to say when something happens:

Pattern	Example
on + day	I have English <b>on Monday</b> .
on + day	I play football <b>on Saturday</b> .
on + day	We go to the park <b>on Sunday</b> .
on + days (plural)	I have art <b>on Wednesdays</b> .

### Example Activities for Each Day:

<b>On Monday,</b>	I go to school.
<b>On Tuesday,</b>	I have music class.
<b>On Wednesday,</b>	I draw pictures.
<b>On Thursday,</b>	I play with friends.
<b>On Friday,</b>	I watch a film.
<b>On Saturday,</b>	I play in the park.
<b>On Sunday,</b>	I rest at home.

## Part 5: Days of the Week Song!

**Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday,  
Friday, Saturday, Sunday!**  
**Seven days, seven days, seven days in a week!**

**Monday** — I go to school!  
**Tuesday** — I learn something cool!  
**Wednesday** — I paint and draw!  
**Thursday** — I play some more!  
**Friday** — the week is done!  
**Saturday** — time for fun!  
**Sunday** — I rest and play!  
**Then it starts again — hooray!**

### Example Dialogue

<b>Tom:</b>		Yesterday was Tuesday.
<b>Teacher</b>	:	What do you do on Saturdays?
<b>Tom:</b>		On Saturday, I play football!
