Numbers 11-20

Learn to count from eleven to twenty, spell them, and use them!

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

- ✓ Count from **11 to 20** in English
- ✓ **Spell** all numbers correctly: eleven, twelve... twenty
- ✓ Know the **-teen pattern** and tricky spellings
- ✓ Use numbers in context: **age, counting, prices**
- ✓ Ask "**How many?**" and "**How old are you?**"

Part 1: Numbers 11 to 20

#	Spelling	How to Say	Tip
11	eleven	eh-LEV-en	Special! Memorise it.
12	twelve	TWELV	Special! Memorise it.
13	thirteen	thir-TEEN	three → thir + teen
14	fourteen	for-TEEN	four + teen
15	fifteen	fif-TEEN	five → fif + teen
16	sixteen	six-TEEN	six + teen
17	seventeen	sev-en-TEEN	seven + teen
18	eighteen	ay-TEEN	eight + een (one t!)
19	nineteen	nine-TEEN	nine + teen
20	twenty	TWEN-tee	Special! NOT twoteen

SPELLING PATTERNS:

- **11 and 12** are special unique words: eleven, twelve. Memorise them!

- **13-19** all end in **-teen**: thirteen, fourteen, fifteen...
- Watch out! **thirteen** (not threeteen), **fifteen** (not fiveteen), **eighteen** (one t!).
- **20 = twenty**. It does NOT end in -teen.

Part 2: Using Numbers 11-20

Context	Example
Age	My brother is twelve years old.
Counting	There are fifteen students in my class.
Price	The book costs eleven pounds.
Time	It is twelve o'clock. Lunchtime!
Address	I live at number seventeen .
Score	I got twenty out of twenty! Perfect!

- HOW MANY? / HOW OLD?**
- **How many** apples? — **Thirteen** apples.
 - **How old are you?** — I am **eleven** years old.
 - **What number is it?** — It is number **fourteen**.

Part 3: Count 1 to 20!

1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10...
11, 12, 13, 14, 15...
16, 17, 18, 19, 20!

One, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten...
Eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen...
Sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, TWENTY!

- You become a **teenager** at **thirteen** (13)!
