Part 1: Weekend Activities

Activity	Example Sentence
played football	I played football in the park.
watched a film	We watched a film at home.
baked a cake	I baked a cake with Mum.
rode my bike	She rode her bike to the lake.
played video games	He played video games all morning.
visited the park	We visited the park on Sunday.
helped at home	I helped at home after lunch.
painted a picture	She painted a beautiful picture.
listened to music	I listened to music in my room.
visited grandparents	We visited our grandparents.
studied for a test	He studied for his maths test.
went swimming	We went swimming at the pool.
went shopping	Mum and I went shopping.
danced	They danced at the party.
played board games	We played board games together.

Part 2: Reading — Emma's Weekend

Last weekend was really fun for Emma. On Saturday morning, she helped her dad in the garden. They planted flowers and watered the plants together. In the afternoon, Emma visited her best friend Lily. They baked chocolate cookies and watched a funny cartoon. Emma laughed so much! On Sunday, Emma's family walked to the big park near their house. Emma and her brother played on the swings and climbed the big tree. After that, they enjoyed a picnic on the grass. "I love weekends!" Emma said to her mum.

Comprehension: 1) What did Emma do Saturday morning? Helped her dad in the garden. 2) Who did she visit? Her friend Lily. 3) What did they bake? Chocolate cookies. 4) Where did the family go Sunday? The big park. 5) What did they enjoy? A picnic.

Part 3: Talking About the Past

When we talk about finished actions (yesterday, last weekend), we change the verb:
 Most verbs: +ed (played, watched). Ends in -e: +d (baked, danced). Consonant+y: y→i +ed (studied).
 Short CVC: double +ed (stopped).

Every weekend (Present)	Last weekend (Past)
I play football.	I played football.
She watches a film.	She watched a film.
We bake cookies.	We baked cookies.
He studies English.	He studied English.
They visit grandma.	They visited grandma.

Question: What did you do last weekend?
 Answer: I played football and watched a film.
 Yes/No: Did you visit grandma? — Yes, I did. / No, I didn't.
 Negative: I didn't play outside because it rained.
