## Lesson Objectives

- Read and understand a story about ordering food
- Name common food and drink in English
- Order food politely using 'I'd like...' and 'Can I have...?'

## Part 1: Reading – Lunch at Sunny Cafe

It is Saturday afternoon. Leo and his sister Anna go to Sunny Cafe with their dad. They are very hungry!

A waiter comes to their table. "Hello! Would you like to see the menu?" he asks. "Yes, please!" says Dad.

Leo looks at the menu. There are sandwiches, pizza, pasta, salad and soup. There are also chips and chicken nuggets. For drinks, there is orange juice, water, milk and lemonade.

"I'd like a cheese pizza, please," says Leo. "And can I have some orange juice?"

"I'd like a chicken sandwich, please," says Anna. "And I'd like some lemonade."

Dad orders pasta and water. "Would you like some salad too?" asks the waiter. "Yes, please!" says Dad.

The food arrives. "This pizza is delicious!" says Leo. Anna loves her sandwich. "It's really tasty!" she says.

After lunch, the waiter asks, "Would you like some dessert?" Leo says, "I'd like some chocolate ice cream, please!" Anna wants strawberry cake. Dad doesn't want dessert. "No, thank you. Just the bill, please," he says.

"Thank you! The food is lovely here," says Dad. They all smile. It is a very nice lunch!

**Part 4: Grammar — Ordering Food**

**How to Order Food Politely**

I'd like a pizza, please. (I'd like = I would like)  
 Can I have some water, please?  
 I'd like some ice cream, please.

**"Would you like...?" (offering)**

Would you like some salad? — Yes, please. / No, thank you.

Would you like some dessert? — Yes, I'd like some cake.

□ **"some" and "any"**

Use some in positive sentences and offers: "I'd like some water."

Use any in questions and negatives: "Is there any cake?" / "There isn't any soup."

□ **Describing food: delicious, tasty, yummy, lovely, nice, horrible**

At a Restaurant	Example
Ordering food	I'd like a pizza, please.
Ordering drink	Can I have some orange juice?
Waiter offers	Would you like some dessert?
Saying yes	Yes, please!
Saying no	No, thank you.
Asking for bill	Just the bill, please.
