Do you like science?	Yes, I do. / No, I don't.
What is your favourite subject?	My favourite subject is music.
Does she like PE?	Yes, she does. She loves PE!
When do you have maths?	I have maths on Tuesday and Thursday.

□ Remember!

I have maths on Monday. Use "on" + day.

I like art. / I don't like history.

My favourite subject is music.

□ Useful Phrases

I love music! (= I like it very much)

I don't like homework. (= it's not nice for me)

I'm good at maths. (= I do it well)

I'm not good at art. (= it's difficult for me)
