Part 1: Telling the Time

Clock	We Say	Numbers
<input type="checkbox"/>	one o'clock	1:00
<input type="checkbox"/>	two o'clock	2:00
<input type="checkbox"/>	three o'clock	3:00
<input type="checkbox"/>	four o'clock	4:00
<input type="checkbox"/>	five o'clock	5:00
<input type="checkbox"/>	six o'clock	6:00
<input type="checkbox"/>	seven o'clock	7:00
<input type="checkbox"/>	eight o'clock	8:00

Part 2: Half Past, Quarter Past, Quarter To

Numbers	We Say
1:00	one o'clock
1:30	half past one
1:15	quarter past one
1:45	quarter to two
3:30	half past three
6:15	quarter past six
8:45	quarter to nine

How to Tell the Time

o'clock = minute hand on 12 (e.g. 3:00 = three o'clock)

half past = minute hand on 6 (e.g. 3:30 = half past three)

quarter past = minute hand on 3 (e.g. 3:15 = quarter past three)

quarter to = minute hand on 9 (e.g. 2:45 = quarter to three)

Part 3: Grammar — My Daily Routine

Time	Activity
7:00	I wake up at seven o'clock.
7:30	I have breakfast at half past seven.
8:00	I go to school at eight o'clock.
12:30	I have lunch at half past twelve.
3:00	I go home at three o'clock.
6:00	I have dinner at six o'clock.
8:30	I go to bed at half past eight.

Remember!

Use "at" before the time: "I wake up at seven o'clock."

What time do you wake up? — I wake up at seven o'clock.

What time does she go to school? — She goes to school at eight o'clock.

Useful Verbs

wake up — open your eyes in the morning

have breakfast / lunch / dinner — eat a meal

go to school — travel to school

go home — travel back to your house

go to bed — sleep at night

brush my teeth — clean your teeth

get dressed — put on your clothes
