<input type="checkbox"/>	building	a structure with walls and a roof
<input type="checkbox"/>	caravan	a home on wheels

Question	Answer
Where do you live?	I live in a house.
Where does she live?	She lives in a cottage.
Where does he live?	He lives near the park.
Do you live in a city?	Yes, I do. / No, I don't.

#### Remember!

I / You / We / They → live | He / She / It → lives

There is + one thing | There are + many things

#### Prepositions of Place

next to — The shop is next to the school.

near — I live near the park.

between — The library is between the shop and the hospital.

opposite — The restaurant is opposite the church.
