## What You Will Learn

- ✓ Ask past questions with Did you / What did you
- ✓ Answer: Yes, I did / No, I didn't
- ✓ Use time expressions: yesterday, last weekend, ago
- ✓ Read an email exchange about weekends
- ✓ Write an email about your weekend

## Part 1: When Did It Happen?

Time Expression	Meaning
<b>yesterday</b>	the day before today
<b>last weekend</b>	Sat & Sun before
<b>last night</b>	evening before
<b>last Monday</b>	Monday before this one
<b>two days ago</b>	2 days before today
<b>a week ago</b>	7 days before
<b>last month</b>	month before
<b>this morning</b>	morning of today
<b>last summer</b>	summer before
<b>on my birthday</b>	your birthday

Verb Review: play→played, watch→watched, cook→cooked, visit→visited, help→helped, enjoy→enjoyed | go→went, see→saw, eat→ate, buy→bought, make→made, have→had

I didn't do anything exciting on Saturday because I was ill. I stayed in bed and watched cartoons. My mum made me chicken soup. On Sunday I felt better. I went to the park with my dad. We played badminton and I won three games! I helped my dad cook dinner — we made spaghetti bolognese together.

### Part 3: Asking About the Past

Yes/No: Did you go to the park? — Yes, I did. / No, I didn't.

Wh-: What did you do? / Where did you go? / Who did you see?

How was your weekend? — It was great!

After Did → always BASE form (go, eat, play — NOT went, ate, played)

Negative: Subject + didn't + base verb

I didn't go to the cinema. She didn't play football. We didn't see any birds.
