Jack's Dream: Kenya Safari — "I am going to save my pocket money. My dad and I are going to fly to Nairobi and stay in a safari lodge. I think we will see lions, elephants and giraffes! Mia's Dream: Australia Road Trip — "We are going to rent a car and drive along the coast. I think we will see kangaroos and koalas! We are going to visit the Great Barrier Reef. I think the coral will be the most beautiful thing ever. We are going to sleep in a tent on the beach. We will probably get lost but that's the fun!"

### Part 3: Going to vs Will

Going to = plans we already decided: I am going to visit Japan. (already planned)  
 = something about to happen: Look! It is going to rain.

Will = predictions: I think it will be fun.  
 = quick decisions: I will have the pizza.  
 = promises: I will send you a postcard!

Going to (plans)	Will (predictions/decisions)
I am going to fly to Paris.	<b>I think Paris will be beautiful.</b>
We are going to stay at a hotel.	<b>The hotel will probably be expensive.</b>
She is going to visit her aunt.	<b>She will love Japan!</b>
He isn't going to take his tablet.	<b>He won't be bored.</b>
