Part 1: Reading — Making Pancakes with Grandma

It is Sunday morning. Oscar and Grace are at Grandma's house. "Can we make pancakes?" asks Oscar.

Grandma gets flour, eggs, milk, sugar and butter from the fridge and cupboard.

"First, put the flour in a big bowl," says Grandma. "Then, add one egg and some sugar." Grace cracks the egg.

"Next, pour in the milk. Now, mix everything together." Grace uses a big spoon to mix.

Grandma heats a frying pan. She puts butter in the pan. "Pour a little batter into the pan." When it is golden, Grandma flips it!

"Finally, put the pancake on a plate." They make ten pancakes! Oscar puts chocolate sauce on his. Grace puts strawberries and cream on hers.

"These pancakes are delicious!" says Oscar. "You are very good chefs!" says Grandma.

Put the flour in a bowl. Add one egg. Mix everything.

Don't forget the sugar! (negative)

Sequence Words

First... Then... Next... After that... Finally...

Step	Instruction
1. First	Put flour in a bowl.
2. Then	Add one egg and sugar.
3. Next	Pour in the milk.
4. After that	Mix everything together.
5. Then	Pour batter into a hot pan.
6. Finally	Flip, cook, put on a plate!
