## Lesson Objectives

## Part 1: Reading — Sports Day

Today is Sports Day! Three teams: Red, Blue, Green. The sun is shining!

Running race: Sam is faster than everyone. He wins for the Blue Team!

Long jump: Mia jumps further than all the children — 2 metres!

Egg and spoon: Noah doesn't drop the egg. Ella drops hers three times but doesn't give up!

Throwing: Zara throws further than the boys! She is the best at throwing.

Relay race: The Blue Team is faster than the Green Team. Blue Team wins!

Results: 3rd Green, 2nd Red, 1st Blue! Every child gets a medal. "You are all winners because you tried your best!"

**Comparatives**  
 Sam is faster than everyone. Mia jumps further than the others.  
 fast → faster, far → further, good → better

**Superlatives**  
 Sam is the fastest. Zara is the best at throwing.

| Adjective | Comparative     | Superlative   |
|-----------|-----------------|---------------|
| fast      | faster (than)   | the fastest   |
| strong    | stronger (than) | the strongest |
| far       | further (than)  | the furthest  |
| good      | better (than)   | the best      |
