7	lemon	a yellow sour fruit

Part 3 — How to Say It

Saying what you like:

Describing fruit:

- An apple is **red**. It is **round**.
- A banana is **yellow**. It is **long**.
- Grapes are **small** and **purple**.
- A strawberry is **red** and **sweet**.

Part 4 — Mia's Fruit Day

Read this short story. The **fruit words** are in bold orange.

My name is **Mia**. I am **seven** years old. I love fruit!

In the morning, I eat a **banana**. It is yellow and sweet. My mum says: "Bananas are good for you!"

At school, I have an **apple** in my bag. It is red and round. I eat it at break time. My friend Tom has an **orange**. He shares it with me. Oranges are juicy!

After school, my dad makes a fruit salad. He puts **strawberries**, **grapes**, and **watermelon** in a big bowl. The strawberries are small and red. The grapes are purple. The watermelon is green outside and pink inside. Yummy!

I don't like **lemons**. Lemons are sour! But my mum puts lemon in her water. She says it is healthy.

At night, my dad gives me a **peach**. It is soft and sweet. I eat it and say: "Thank you, Dad!"

I eat fruit **every day**. Fruit makes me happy.
