### Meet the drinks!

These are the 10 drinks you will learn today. Click them in the online lesson to hear the pronunciation!

Drink	Say it	What is it?
<b>water</b>	<i>/waw-ter/</i>	a clear drink with no colour or taste
<b>milk</b>	<i>/milk/</i>	a white drink from cows, good for bones
<b>orange juice</b>	<i>/or-indj joos/</i>	a sweet orange drink from oranges
<b>apple juice</b>	<i>/ap-el joos/</i>	a sweet drink made from apples
<b>lemonade</b>	<i>/lem-e-nayd/</i>	a sweet and sour drink with lemons
<b>tea</b>	<i>/tee/</i>	a hot drink made with leaves and water
<b>hot chocolate</b>	<i>/hot chok-let/</i>	a warm sweet brown drink with chocolate
<b>smoothie</b>	<i>/smoo-dhee/</i>	a thick drink made from fruit and milk
<b>milkshake</b>	<i>/milk-shayk/</i>	a sweet cold drink with milk and ice cream
<b>coconut water</b>	<i>/koh-ke-nut waw-ter/</i>	water from inside a coconut

## PART 3 — LANGUAGE FOCUS

### How to say it

#### Saying what you want

We use **Can I have** to ask for a drink. We use **I like** and **I don't like** to talk about drinks.

**Can I have** some water, please?

**I like** orange juice.

**I don't like** coffee.

**Do you want** some milk?

## Describing drinks

Water is **cold**. It has **no colour**.

Milk is **white**. It is **good for your bones**.

Orange juice is **sweet** and **orange**.

Tea is **hot**. You drink it from a **cup**.

## PART 4 — READING

### Leo's Thirsty Day

My name is **Leo**. I am **eight** years old. Today is a very hot day!

In the morning, I drink a glass of **milk**. It is white and cold. My mum says: "Milk is good for your bones!"

At school, I have a bottle of **water** in my bag. Water has no colour. I drink it when I am thirsty. My friend Mia has **apple juice**. She shares it with me. Apple juice is sweet!

At lunch, my teacher gives us **orange juice**. It is cold and orange. I like orange juice very much. "Can I have more, please?" I ask. My teacher smiles and says: "Of course!"

After school, I am very hot. My dad makes me a **lemonade**. He uses lemons, water, and sugar. It is yellow and sour and sweet at the same time. I drink it all!

In the evening, my mum makes **hot chocolate**. It is brown and warm and sweet. I drink it slowly. It is my favourite drink in winter. "Thank you, Mum!" I say.

At bedtime, I drink a small glass of **water** again. My dad says: "Water is always the best drink!" I think he is right.
