Vocabulary: Left & Right Words

#		Word	Definition
1	←	left	the side of your body where your heart is
2	→	right	the opposite side of left; most people write with this hand
3	☞	hand	the part of your body at the end of your arm, with five fingers
4	☞	foot	the part of your body at the end of your leg; you walk on it
5	☞	turn	to change the direction you are going
6	☞	point	to use your finger to show where something is
7	↔	next to	very close to something; beside it
8	☞	between	in the middle of two things
9	☞	arm	the long part of your body between your shoulder and your hand
10	☞	finger	one of the five thin parts at the end of your hand

Story: Ben's Left and Right Day

My name is Ben. I am seven years old. Today I am learning about **left** and **right**!

My teacher says: "Raise your **left hand**!" I raise my left hand. My heart is on the left side. That helps me remember!

Then she says: "Raise your **right hand**!" I raise my right hand. I write with my right hand.

We play a game. The teacher says: "**Turn left**!" We all turn left. "**Turn right**!" We all turn right. "**Stamp your left foot**!" I stamp my left foot. Boom!

"**Point to the window**!" says the teacher. I use my **finger** to point. The window is on the right. "**Point to the door**!" The door is on the left.

At break time, I sit **between** my friends Tom and Sara. Tom is on my left. Sara is on my right. The juice is **next to** my sandwich.

Now I know left and right! I can use my **hands**, my feet, and my **arms**. Left and right is easy and fun!
