	T-shirt	a soft top with short sleeves
	trousers	they cover your legs
	shoes	you wear them on your feet to walk
	jacket	you wear it when it is cold or rainy
	dress	top and skirt together in one piece
	hat	you wear it on your head
	socks	you wear them inside your shoes
	scarf	a long cloth around your neck
	shorts	short trousers for hot days
	boots	strong shoes that cover your ankles

Clothes for weather:
