□ VOCABULARY □

Word	Meaning
□ broom	a brush with a long handle for sweeping
□ sponge	a soft thing for washing dishes or tables
□ bin	you put rubbish in this
□ soap	use this with water to make things clean
□ gloves	put these on your hands to keep them safe
□ bucket	a round container you fill with water
□ towel	a cloth you use to dry things
□ clean	not dirty — nice and tidy
□ dirty	not clean — has mud or marks on it
□ sweep	to push dirt off the floor with a broom

↔ CLEAN vs DIRTY ↔

□ clean = nice and tidy	□ dirty = mud, food, or marks
□ The table is clean!	□ The floor is dirty!
□ My hands are clean now.	□ My shoes are dirty!

☐ CLEANING DAY! ☐

Read this story. The vocabulary words are in **green bold**.

Today is Saturday. It is cleaning day! Mum says: "Let's **clean** the house together!"

Lily looks around. The house is **dirty**! There are toys on the floor. There is food on the table. There are muddy shoes by the door. "Oh no!" says Lily.

Dad gets the **broom**. He sweeps the kitchen floor. Swish, swish, swish! The dirt goes away. "The floor is **clean** now!" says Dad.

Mum fills a **bucket** with warm water. She puts **soap** in the water. Bubbles! She uses a **sponge** to wash the table. Wipe, wipe, wipe! "The table is **clean**!" says Mum.

Little brother Tom picks up his toys. He puts his rubbish in the **bin**. "Good job, Tom!" says Lily.

Lily puts on **gloves**. She washes the dishes. She uses a **towel** to dry the plates. One, two, three — all dry!

Now the house is **clean**! The floor is shiny. The table is tidy. Everything looks nice.

"Well done, everyone!" says Mum. "Now let's have cake!" ☐☐

"YAY!" say Lily and Tom together.

Giving instructions (imperatives):

Instruction	What it means
☐ Sweep the floor!	Push the broom on the floor.
☐ Wash the table!	Use a sponge and water.
☐ Put it in the bin!	Throw rubbish away.
☐ Dry the dishes!	Use a towel to remove water.
☐ Use soap!	Make things clean with soap and water.
