Reading: Lily Crosses the Road

Read the story. The road words are in **orange bold**.

My name is **Lily**. I am six years old. Today I walk to school with my mum.

We walk on the **pavement**. The pavement is **safe**. **Cars** drive on the **road**. We do not walk on the road!

We come to a big road. There is a **traffic light**. It is red. Red means **stop**! We wait.

My mum says: "**Look** left. Look right. Look left again."

I look left. I see a **bus**. It is big and yellow. It stops too.

I look right. No cars. I look left again. The bus is not moving.

Now the light is green. Green means **go**! We walk on the **crossing**. The white lines are on the road. Cars wait for us.

My mum holds my hand. We walk. Not fast, not slow. We look and walk.

We are on the other side. We are safe!

"Good job, Lily!" says my mum. "You looked left and right. You are very clever!"

I smile. I know how to cross the road. Look. Wait. Go. Easy!

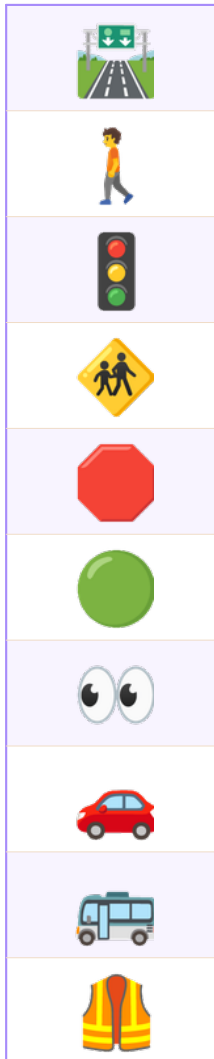
