Where is water?

 Water is **in** the sea. |  Water is **in** the river. |  Rain comes **from** the clouds. |  I drink water **from** a glass.

Water changes!

 Water is a **liquid**. It flows. |  When very **cold**, water becomes **ice**. | When very **hot**, water becomes **steam**.

A Drop of Water

My name is **Drip**. I am a little **drop** of **water**. Let me tell you about my amazing journey!

I live in the **sea**. The sea is very big. It is blue and **salty**. I swim with the fish all day. But one day, the sun is very hot. I feel warm. Warmer and warmer. I start to go up! Up, up, up into the sky!


Now I am in a **cloud**. The cloud is white and soft. I meet many other drops of water. "Hello!" I say. There are millions of us in the cloud!

The cloud moves over the land. It gets bigger and darker. Then... drip, drip, drip! I start to fall. I am **rain**! I fall down, down, down from the sky.

Splash! I land in a **river**. The river is long and fast. It carries me through green fields and under bridges. The water is **fresh**. Not salty like the sea!

The river goes to a big **lake**. The lake is calm and quiet. I rest here. Birds swim on top. Children play near the water.

But I don't stop. The river carries me again. Faster and faster! And then... I see it. The sea! I am back home!

"I did it!" I say. "Sea → sky → rain → river → lake → sea. That is the **water cycle**!" And tomorrow? I will do it again!
