# Shapes Around Me

Learn the names of shapes and find them in real life!

## Vocabulary

	Word	Meaning
	<b>circle</b>	round; no corners
	<b>square</b>	4 equal sides, 4 corners
	<b>triangle</b>	3 sides, 3 corners
	<b>rectangle</b>	4 sides: 2 long, 2 short
	<b>star</b>	5 points
	<b>diamond</b>	like a square turned sideways
	<b>side</b>	one line of a shape
	<b>corner</b>	where two sides meet
	<b>round</b>	shaped like a circle
	<b>shape</b>	the form of something

## Language Focus

### Describing shapes:

 A circle is **round**. |  A square has **4 equal sides**. |  A triangle has **3 sides**. |  A rectangle has **2 long and 2 short sides**.

### Shapes in real life:

Clock = circle | Door = rectangle | Pizza slice = triangle | Phone = rectangle | Ball = round

## The Shape Hunt

My name is **Ravi**. I am **eight** years old. Today, my teacher says: "Let's go on a **shape** hunt!" My friend Mia and I are very excited.

We take our notebooks and go outside. "Find as many shapes as you can!"

First, I look up. The sun is a **circle**! "I found one!" I say. A clock on the wall is a circle too.


Mia looks at the building. "The windows are **squares**!" she says. Each window has four **equal** sides.

Then I see the door. "The door is a **rectangle**!" It has two long sides and two short sides.

We walk to the playground. The slide is a **triangle** from the side! "Three sides!" says Mia.

On the ground, I see a **diamond** shape in the tiles. Mia sees a **star** on the flag. "Five points!" she says.

I look at the football. The ball is **round**. But it also has small pentagons and hexagons on it! Cool!

We go back to class. I found 8 shapes! Mia found 10! "Well done!" says our teacher. "Shapes are all around us!"
