□ VOCABULARY □

	Word	Meaning
□	raincoat	a special coat for rainy days
□	boots	tall shoes that keep your feet dry
☂	umbrella	hold it over your head in the rain
□	gloves	warm things for your hands
□	scarf	a long cloth around your neck
□	wet	covered in water
☀	dry	no water — the opposite of wet
□	puddle	a small pool of water on the ground
□	splash	jump in water — it goes everywhere
□	waterproof	water cannot go through it

↔ WET vs DRY ↔

□ wet = covered in water	* dry = no water
□ I fell in a puddle! I am wet!	* My boots are waterproof. My feet are dry!
□ The ground is wet after rain.	* My umbrella keeps me dry!

□ NOAH'S RAINY DAY □

Read this story. The vocabulary words are in **blue bold**.

My name is Noah. I am seven years old. Today it is raining. I love rainy days!

I look out the window. The rain goes drip, drip, drip. There are puddles on the ground!

"Put on your rainy day clothes!" says Mum.

First, I put on my warm socks and my **boots**. My **boots** are red. They are **waterproof**. My feet will stay **dry**!

Then, I put on my **raincoat**. It is big and yellow. It has a hood. My **raincoat** is **waterproof** too!

I put on my **gloves**. They are blue. I also put on my **scarf**. It is green and very soft.

Mum gives me my **umbrella**. It has rainbow colours! I love my **umbrella**!

We go outside. The rain falls on my **umbrella**. Pitter-patter, pitter-patter!

I see a big **puddle**. I run. I jump. **SPLASH!** Water goes everywhere! My **boots** keep my feet **dry**. But my face is a little bit **wet**. I don't care. It is fun!

I jump again. **SPLASH! SPLASH! SPLASH!** I am the **puddle** king! □□

After playing, we go home. I take off my **wet boots** and **raincoat**. Mum gives me warm milk.

I look out the window. The rain has stopped. I can see a rainbow! □ What a perfect day.
