- B** — A 'boarding pass' is the document you show to get on a plane.
- C** — 'Delayed' means arriving or departing later than planned.
- A** — 'Book' means to reserve something in advance, such as a hotel room.
- D** — A 'suitcase' is a bag you carry your clothes and belongings in when travelling.
- C** — 'Take off' means a plane leaves the ground and starts flying.
- A** — A 'souvenir' is a small item you buy to remember a place you visited.
- B** — A 'bus' is a common form of public transport that takes you around a city.
- D** — 'Reception' is the desk at the entrance of a hotel where you check in.
- A** — A 'ferry' is a boat that carries passengers and vehicles across water.
- C** — A 'guided tour' is a visit to a place with a person who explains its history and features.
- D** — 'Miss' means to arrive too late to catch a bus, train, or plane.
- A** — 'Get off' means to leave a bus, train, or plane.
- C** — 'Turn left/right' is the common way to give directions at a junction.
- B** — 'Delayed' means the flight departed later than scheduled.
- D** — A 'double room' has a large bed for two people.
