Explanations

- B** — With he/she/it, we add -s to the verb: she goes.
- A** — With I/you/we/they, we use the base verb: I play.
- C** — With he/she/it, verbs ending in -ch get -es: he watches.
- D** — With they, we use the base verb: they study.
- A** — 'My cat' = it, so we add -s: likes.
- C** — With we, we use the base verb: we have.
- B** — 'My dad' = he, so we add -s: he works.
- D** — 'The children' = they, so we use the base verb: they play.
- A** — With she, verbs ending in -sh get -es: she brushes.
- C** — With I, we use the base verb: I drink.
- D** — With he/she/it, the negative is doesn't + base verb: she doesn't like.
- B** — With you, we use 'Do' to make a question: Do you live...?
- A** — With we, the negative is don't + base verb: we don't eat.
- C** — 'Your sister' = she. With he/she/it, we use 'Does': Does your sister speak...?
- D** — 'My brother' = he. The negative is doesn't + base verb: he doesn't play.
- B** — With you, Wh- questions use 'do': Where do you go...?
- A** — With they, the negative is don't + base verb: they don't watch.
- C** — 'The film' = it. With he/she/it, we use 'does': What time does the film start?
- D** — 'Tom' = he. The negative is doesn't + base verb: Tom doesn't go.
- B** — Short answer to 'Do you...?' is 'Yes, I do.' We don't repeat the main verb.
- A** — Short answer to 'Does she...?' is 'No, she doesn't.'

- 22. C** — 'My mum' = she. With he/she/it, add -s: she gets up.
- 23. B** — 'Your best friend' = he/she. With he/she, we use 'does': What does your best friend look like?
- 24. D** — With I, the negative is don't + base verb: I don't go.
- 25. C** — 'He' takes the -s form: he does his homework.
- 26. A** — With they, we use 'Do' to ask a question: Do they have...?
- 27. B** — 'My teacher' = he/she. The negative is doesn't + base verb: doesn't give.
- 28. D** — 'She' takes the -s form: she listens.
- 29. A** — With you, we use 'do': How often do you visit...?
- 30. C** — With he, verbs ending in consonant + y change to -ies: he studies.
