Explanations

- B** — The number 8 is spelled 'eight'.
- C** — The days go: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday... Tuesday comes after Monday.
- A** — January is the first month of the year.
- D** — There are seven days in a week.
- B** — The number 12 is spelled 'twelve'.
- A** — The months go: ...June, July, August... August comes after July.
- C** — Wednesday is between Tuesday and Thursday.
- D** — The number 50 is spelled 'fifty'.
- B** — Sunday is the last day of the week.
- A** — The number 15 is spelled 'fifteen'.
- D** — February has 28 days (or 29 in a leap year), the fewest of any month.
- C** — The ordinal form of 3 is 'third' (1st = first, 2nd = second, 3rd = third).
- B** — $20 + 13 = 33$, which is 'thirty-three'.
- A** — Christmas Day is on 25th December.
- D** — After nineteenth (19th) comes twentieth (20th).
- C** — September is the 9th month of the year.
- B** — 6:30 is 'half past six'. 'Six thirty' is also correct but 'half past six' is the standard British English form.
- A** — April is the 4th month. The ordinal form is 'fourth'.
- D** — The number 40 is spelled 'forty' (not 'fourty' — this is a common mistake).
- C** — May comes before June and July comes after June.
- A** — The ordinal form of 2 is 'second'. We say 'the second of March'.

- 22. B** — 7:15 is 'quarter past seven'. The minute hand is at quarter past.
- 23. D** — Two days before Wednesday is Monday (Tuesday is one day before, Monday is two).
- 24. C** — 2005 is usually said as 'two thousand and five' in British English.
- 25. A** — There are twelve (12) months in a year, from January to December.
- 26. B** — 3:45 is 'quarter to four' — 15 minutes before 4 o'clock.
- 27. D** — 100 is 'one hundred'. Be careful with the spelling: h-u-n-d-r-e-d.
- 28. C** — New Year's Day is on the 1st of January, the first day of the year.
- 29. A** — Four months have 30 days: April, June, September and November.
- 30. B** — Friday comes before Saturday in the week.
