## Explanations

- 1. C** — 'Water' is a drink. Bread, rice and cheese are foods, not drinks.
- 2. A** — An 'apple' is a common fruit that can be red or green.
- 3. D** — 'Bread' (often as toast) is commonly eaten for breakfast with butter or jam.
- 4. B** — An 'egg' comes from a chicken. Cheese and milk come from cows.
- 5. A** — 'Tea' is a popular hot drink, often served with milk or sugar.
- 6. C** — A 'banana' is a long, curved yellow fruit.
- 7. D** — 'Sweet' describes the taste of sugar, chocolate, ice cream and cake.
- 8. B** — 'Breakfast, lunch and dinner' are the three main meals of the day.
- 9. A** — A 'carrot' is an orange vegetable. It is healthy and rabbits love it.
- 10. C** — A 'menu' is a list of food and drinks you can order at a restaurant.
- 11. D** — A 'potato' is a vegetable, not a fruit. Apple, banana and strawberry are all fruits.
- 12. B** — 'Sour' describes the sharp taste of lemons and limes.
