Explanations

- B** — 'Tall' describes a person with great height. 190 cm is very tall.
- C** — 'Small' is the opposite of 'big'.
- A** — 'Long hair' means hair that reaches past the shoulders.
- D** — 'Cold' is the opposite of 'hot'.
- C** — 'Kind' means nice and helpful. A teacher who helps and smiles is kind.
- A** — A 'funny' person says or does things that make people laugh.
- B** — 'Fast' means moving quickly. A car that goes 300 km/h is very fast.
- D** — 'Old' describes someone who has lived for many years. 85 is old.
- A** — The sky is 'blue' when the weather is sunny and clear.
- C** — 'Dirty' is the opposite of 'clean'.
- D** — A 'shy' person is nervous or uncomfortable around new people and does not talk much.
- A** — 'Heavy' means weighing a lot. A 30-kilo bag is very heavy.
- C** — We describe a person's eye colour: blue eyes, brown eyes, green eyes.
- B** — 'Cheap' is the opposite of 'expensive'. Cheap means it does not cost much.
- D** — A 'lazy' person does not want to do work and prefers to rest or do nothing.
- A** — To describe a person with an adjective, we use 'is': He is tall.
- C** — To describe hair, eyes or body parts, we use 'has': She has long brown hair.
- B** — A 'brave' person is not afraid and has courage.
- D** — A football is 'round' — it has the shape of a circle or sphere.
- A** — A 'clever' (or smart) person learns quickly and understands things well.
- C** — 'It is a big red car' is correct. We use 'is' + adjective for things. The others mix up 'is' and 'has'.

- 22. B** — 'Old' is the opposite of 'young' when talking about people.
- 23. A** — 2 kilos is very light, so the cat is 'small', and her fur is 'white'.
- 24. D** — 'Friendly' describes personality (how a person acts). Tall, blonde and thin describe appearance (how a person looks).
- 25. B** — 'Heavy' is the opposite of 'light' when talking about weight.
- 26. C** — A pirate typically has 'long hair' and a 'beard'.
- 27. A** — 'Cheap' means it does not cost much money. 50 euros for a phone is cheap.
- 28. D** — A 'quiet' person speaks softly or not very often and does not make much noise.
- 29. B** — In English, adjectives go before the noun: size + colour + noun = 'a big red car'.
- 30. C** — 'Old' is the opposite of 'new' when talking about things (an old phone, an old car).
